Game	Quick Instructions	EST Time	Materials and Props
Team Raahs!	Have teams come up with Names and think of a cheer!	20 min.	Sitting in groups on the floor.
Mini Pumpkin Toss	With one tosser per team, little marshmallows are tossed to a team member sitting in a chair, who catches the marshmallow in a Solo Cup.	5 min.	6 containers of mini marshmallows 6 chairs and a taped of distance between chair and tosser. Also need 6 chairs for the candy. 6 Solo Cups
Monster Mummy Wrap	Each team is given 2 rolls of TP which they must use to completely wrap one of their team mates with.	5 min.	12 Rolls of TP (2 for each team) "Mummies" must be completely wrapped.
Pumpkin Pie Eating Contest	Teams members will take turns eat slices of pumpkin pie, using only their mouths. First team to eat the whole pie wins.	5 to 10 min.	6 - 8" Pumpkin pies, cut for 6 to 8 slices. Whip Cream to top each piece of pie.
Jack-O-Jigsaw	Teams must reassemble a cut pumpkin. First team to correct reassemble their pumpkin wins!	10 min.	6 medium to large pumpkins, cut to an equal number of pieces. Toothpicks, 6 large foiled trays.
Pumpkin Carving Contest	Teams will be given 10 minutes to carve a full jack-o-lantern including; gutting and carving 2 eyes, 2 ears, 1 nose, and 1 mouth.	10 min.	6 medium to large pumpkins, 6 pumpkin carving kits, trays, trash bags, paper towels.
Candy Corn Challenge	There will be a candy jar filled with counted candy corn. Student as they arrive will be given the opportunity to guess the count by write their name and the number they guess on a card.	Revealed at the end.	The student who comes closest to the correct count wins the jar full of candy corn. Need up to 4 bags of candy corn and 1 sealable candy jar.
