But what if we saw things the way God sees things? What if instead of 3D vision, we started looking at the world with G-D Vision. God's vision goes far beyond our own sight.	
We see the now; the hard times, the difficulties, the "ups and downs" of life. It's that short sightedness that causes us to loose hope. But God sees what's ahead and how those tough times will help to shape us for the very purpose He has created us for.	
We call these tough times, tests. But unlike the tests you get at school, God wants you to pass these test. Listen to this, "Blessed are those who endure when they are tested. When they pass the test, they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love Him." (Mt 24:25 niv.)
